Request For Proposal

Carbon County Weed and Pest (CCWP) is seeking bids/proposals to treat noxious weeds within highway rights of way in Carbon County. CCWP is seeking a certified commercial applicator to treat state designated and county declared species across Carbon County WY. Road miles contracted for treatment will be at least 200 but will not exceed 340 (see attached list). Final contracted miles will be dictated by bid amounts and CCWP budget. The Following are the requirements for the treatments and data/reporting:

- Treat all State Designated weeds found within the ROW of designated roads.
- ROW will be defined as fenced area including ramps.
- Report all spray data in daily spray records as required by state law and the Wyoming department of ag (WDA-188 form).
- Provide point data identifying species treated to CCWP in ESRI Shapefile format.
- Provide daily track logs (Shapefiles) of areas treated.
- Treatments will be spot applications and can be made with any approved application equipment.
- All herbicides will be provided by CCWP.
- Performance Period is May 15 – July 15 and September 1-September 30, 2023.

Please provide bid/proposals to CCWP no later than COB February 10, 2023. Proposal should include proof of licensing and liability insurance, methods to be used, budget detailing all costs and total expected project cost. Preferred method of budgeting is center lane mile basis. Typical state and federal highways are one center lane mile per road mile while interstates will be two center lane miles per road mile. Proposals using other methods may be considered. Contract will be awarded on a best value basis taking cost, applicator experience, equipment, and knowledge of the area into consideration. CCWP reserves the right to reject all bids.
